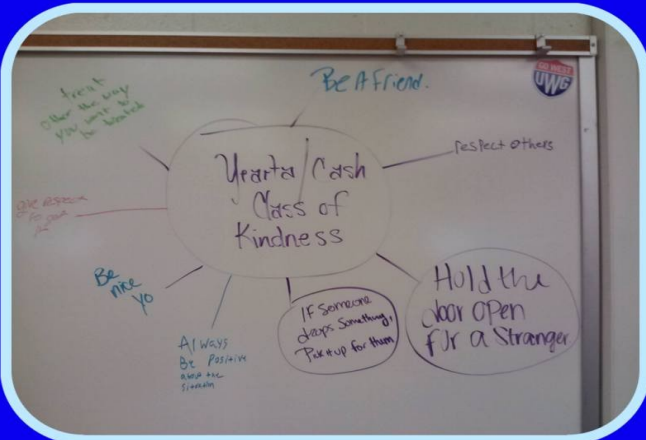


REBELBALL Winner

January- Attendance, February- Grades, March- Discipline, April- Attendance, May- Grades

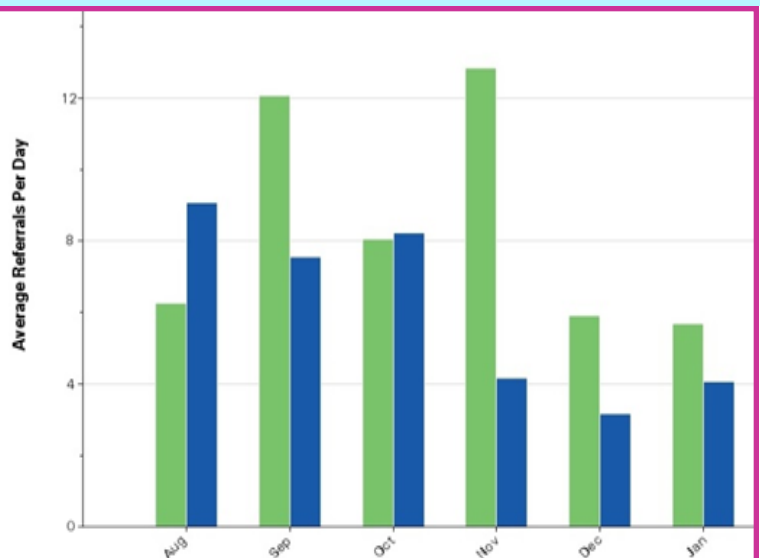


REBELBALL Drawing Winner

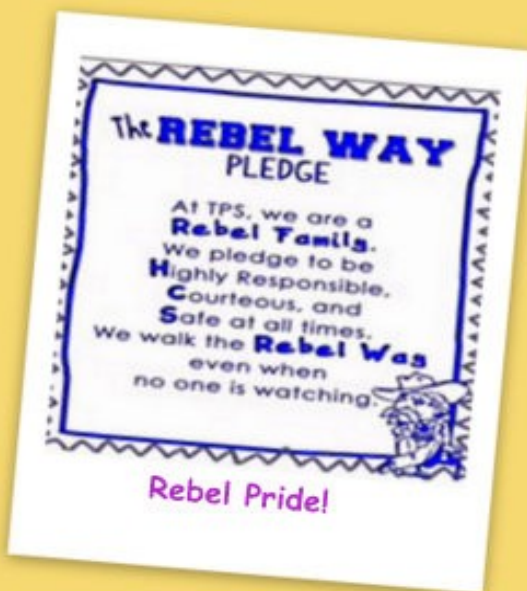

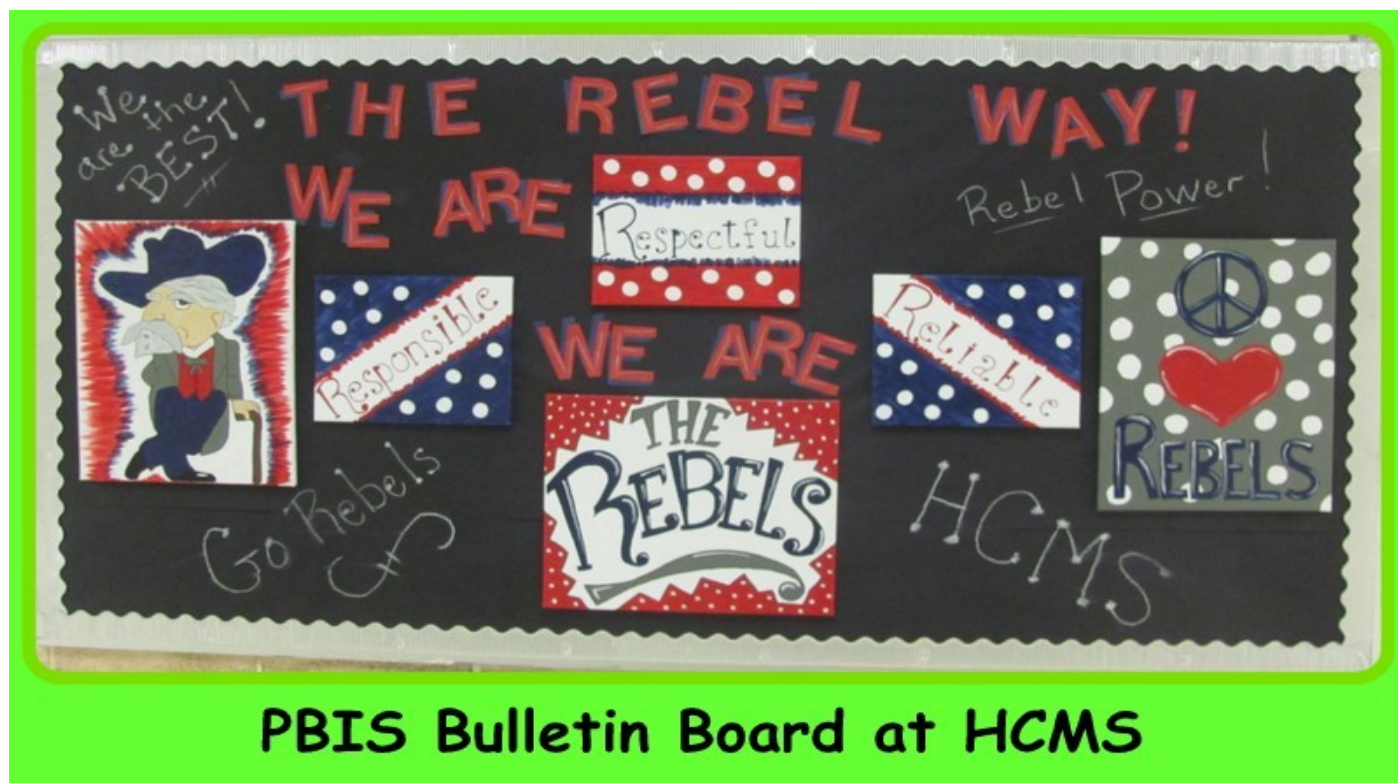


Dr. Seuss at BPS
