HARALSON COUNTY TRACK TEAMS BUILD ON SUCCESS AT SECTIONALS

Saturday, April 27th saw the Haralson County Track Team build on their success by qualifying 4 athletes to their respective state track meets.

The Haralson County Girls Track Team brought 7 athletes in 6 events to the Sectionals held at Lakewood Stadium on Saturday, April 26th. Athletes, top 4 finishers from the region meet, included Morgan and Madison Brooks in the discus; Sarah Flowers in the Pole Vault, 1600, and 4 X 400 Relay; Savannah Ross in the 800 and 4 X 400 Relay; Jada Ross in the 200 and 4 X 400 Relay; and Jaylen Sewell and Hailey Harris (alt.) in the 4 X 400 Relay. It was a great day with all receiving personal best results in each of their events. With a throw of 108' 6", Madison Brooks became the first Haralson County female to qualify for the Girls State Track Meet. Madison will be competing on Thursday, May 1st at the annual meet held in Albany, Georgia.

The Harlason county Boys Track Team saw their success from last year continued, qualifying 4 boys in 4 different events for Sectionals. All four, Tyler Carnes, Tim Dunbar, Brandon Owens, and Kane Sewell, had strong performances at Sectionals with Brandon Owens reaching a personal best height in the high jump. The Boys State Track Meet will be held in Jefferson, Georgia starting May 8th. Tyler Carnes will be making a repeat performance in the discus and will be joined this year by Kane Sewell in the Long Jump, and Brandon Owens in the High Jump.
