

PUBLIC NOTICE
DESTRUCTION OF RECORDS
OF HANDICAPPED STUDENTS

In compliance with both Georgia Special Education Annual Program Plan, the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act and Haralson County School Systems Comprehensive Plan for Special Education policy on destruction of data collected, maintained or used in the provision of a free appropriate public education for handicapped and/or exceptional children in the Haralson County School System, the Department of Special Education announces its intention for destruction of data.

Records on students who were enrolled in a special education program with a birth year of 1998, are no longer needed for education planning purposes. These records may be needed by the student or parent for Social Security, or other reasons. The system plans to destroy these records the last week in February 2021. If you the student, or parents of the student, desire copies of these records prior to destruction, you should contact the Haralson County Schools Special Education Office at 770-574-2500 ext: 41221. Identification will be required.
